"The safety and security of the child lies not so much in the child's hanging about the mother's neck as in the mother's holding it fast in her arms. Likewise, our safety and security lie not so much in our weak holding upon Christ, but in Christ's holding us fast in his everlasting arms. Heartfelt prayer ended in flash flooding. A plague of mice swept through the land. Scone Mountain was lit ablaze with fire. We were left battered but remained fruitful. Two steps forward, one step back—rescued sinners continued to grow in "the grace and knowledge of our Lord" (2 Peter 3:18).

But what gave us the strength to persevere? The source of our endurance is the Lord Jesus. He promises that his elect people will endure to the end (Romans 8:30). "No one will snatch them out of [his] hand" (John 10:28). "[The God] who began a good work in [us] will bring it to completion" (Philippians 1:6). The church will continue to flourish because it lives in the most secure place—the eternal hands of Jesus Christ. He is our glory and our safety.
